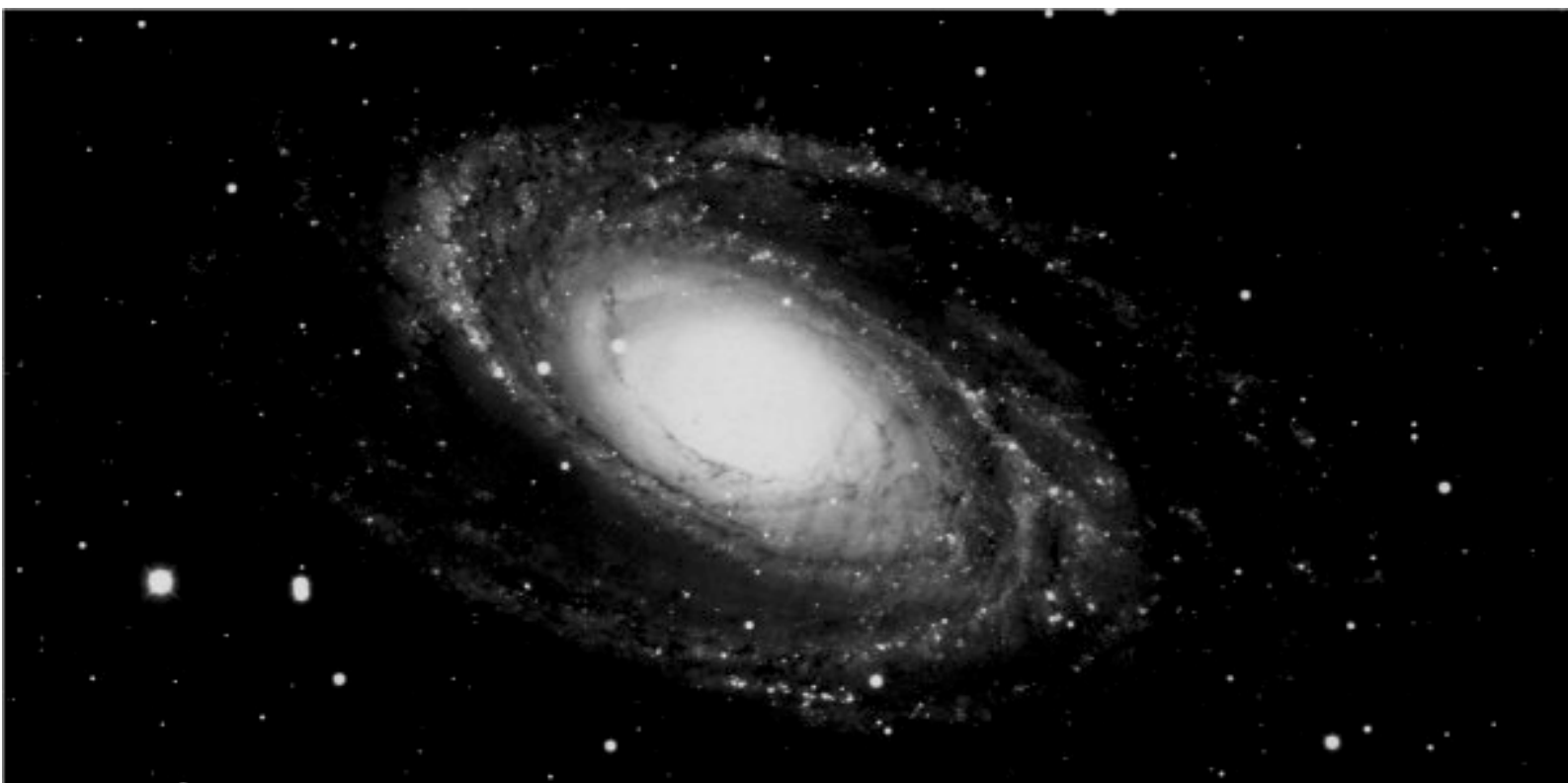

Esperia Hotel (**, 22, Stadiou Str., Athens, Greece, Tel.: +30-10-3238001, Fax: +30-10-3238100)**

All rooms provided with air-conditioning, soundproof windows, colour TV, full stocked mini-bar, direct dial telephone and hairdryer. The hotel is located 100m away from the conference facilities, at a few minutes walk distance from the Acropolis – Plaka region.

Nice hotel located about 500 meters from the conference facilities, with clean air conditioned rooms.

Single: 55 Euros, Double: 65 Euros

All prices include service fees, taxes, VAT and breakfast but not lunch.

Travel and Transportation

Arriving to Athens at the E. Venizelos International Airport (www.aia.gr).

Access to the city center, where the hotels and conference facilities are located, is possible:

- By bus (E95 line) from the airport to Syntagma square.
- By bus (E94 line) from the airport to Ethniki Amina Metro station, and from there to Syntagma Square using metro line 3. You can change there to metro line 2 (Sepolia direction). The next station (Panepistimio) is near Esperia Hotel and the conference location. The subsequent station (Omonoia) is near Grand Hotel.
- By Taxi (fare is estimated to be €20)

There is a Metro station (Panepistimio) outside the conference facility.

Public Transportation Tickets

Airport Express Lines & one day ticket

Ticket price: 2.90 Euro

These tickets are valid for transportation to and from the airport using the express lines. These tickets can also be used as a one day ticket for all transportation means, with only one validation at the first embarkation point.

Please note that this ticket cannot be used for two ways transport (from and to the airport).

You can use this ticket for using the metro system and bus lines plus one way from or to the airport. To go back to the airport you need to buy an additional ticket.

Daily Tickets are sold in the metro stations and at the Airport ticket kiosks (next to the bus stops), kiosks of the Athens Transport Organization (located in bus terminals) and also from the drivers of the Airport Express Lines.

Buses and Trolleys (except the Airport Express Lines)

Ticket price: 0.45 Euro

Tickets are sold in news kiosks, the metro stations and special kiosks of the Athens Transportation Organization.

Metro Line 1 (Kifissia-Pireus: Green Line)

Ticket price: 0.60 Euro for transportation in up to two zones distance, 0.70 Euro for transportation in three zones distance, or for combined use of Line 1 and Line 2 or 3.

1st Zone: Pireus-Monastiraki

2nd Zone: Monastiraki-Ano Patisia

3rd Zone: Ano Patisia-Kifissia

Metro Tickets are sold in the Metro Stations

Metro Lines 2 (Sepolia-Dafni: Red Line) and 3 (Syntagma-Ethniki Amynta: Blue Line)

Ticket price: 0.70 Euro

You can use all the combinations of the metro system, for up to 90 minutes from validation of the ticket. It is not allowed though to exit and reenter the metro system while using the same ticket.

Location and Facilities

- The workshop will take place in the Eastern Hall of the Academy of Athens main building.
- Overhead projector, slides projector, video/computer projector and audio equipment will be available to the speakers in the conference hall.
- Poster sizes should be 90 by 90 centimeters.
- Access to the Internet will be available via a limited number of terminals at the conference location.

Weather

Usually this time of the year the weather in Athens is still warm, but you may need a light jacket or pullover for the evenings.

Registration Fees

Before the deadline, June 30th 2002, no registration fees were required. Late registration, beyond this deadline is possible. However, a registration fee of **100 Euros** for non-scheduled organizational costs is required. The fee should be paid at the registration desk upon arrival.

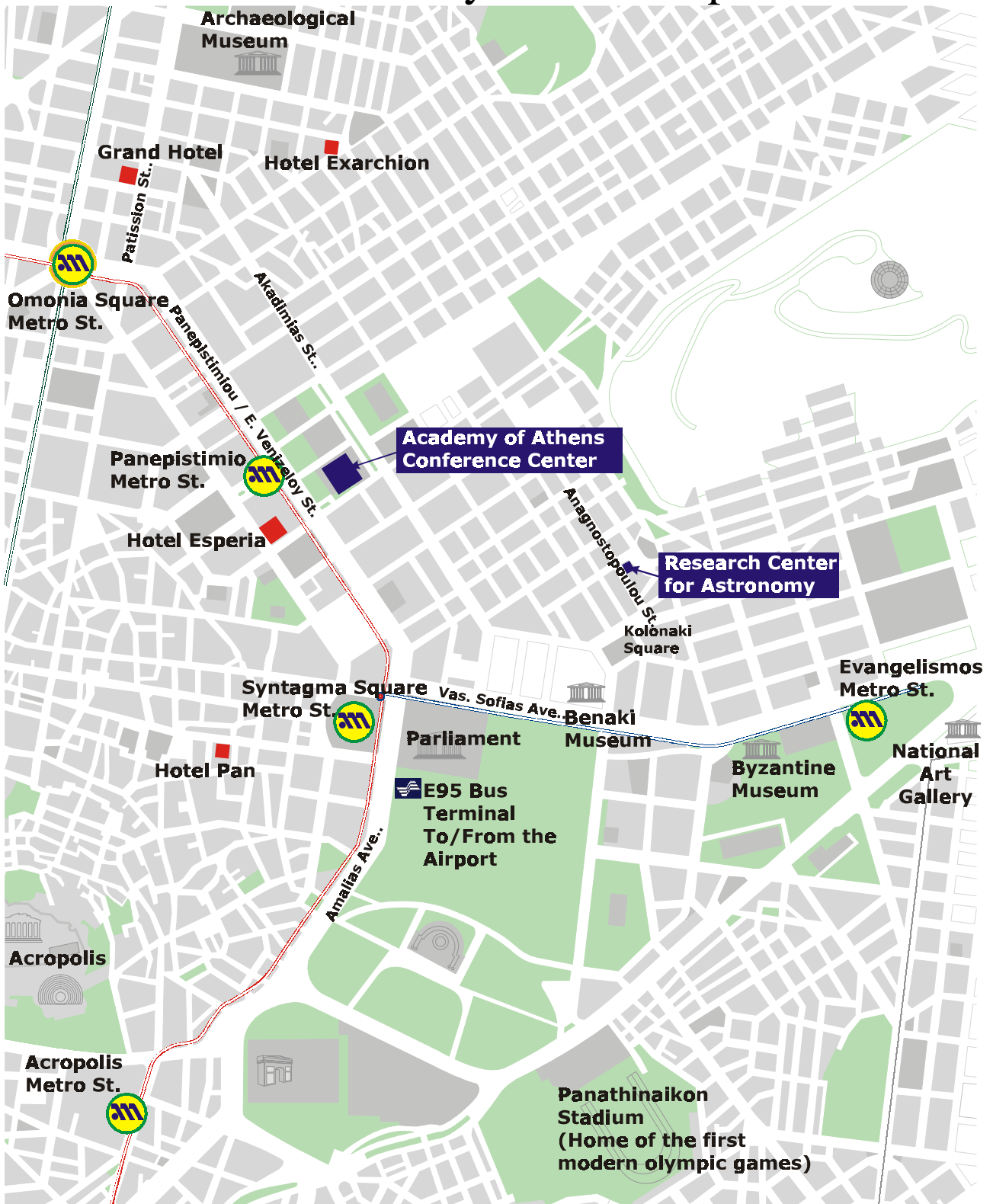
